In alignment with the NEP 2020, CBSE has introduced the Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning (SAFAL) for all students in Classes VI 24-25 (V 23-24) and IX 24-25 (VIII 23-24) to evaluate their level of academic understanding and progress. This assessment focuses on testing core concepts, application of knowledge, and higher-order thinking skills of the respective classes for the previous session 2023-24. Additionally, SAFAL will provide diagnostic information about students' learning, supporting the transition towards competency-based education. SAFAL Exam was conducted successfully at Lightworkers Academy starting from 22nd July 2024 in three batches for each Grade on the subjects English, EVS/Science and Mathematics.

The children made the model of different types of houses using waste materials and learnt the concepts on a practical manner.

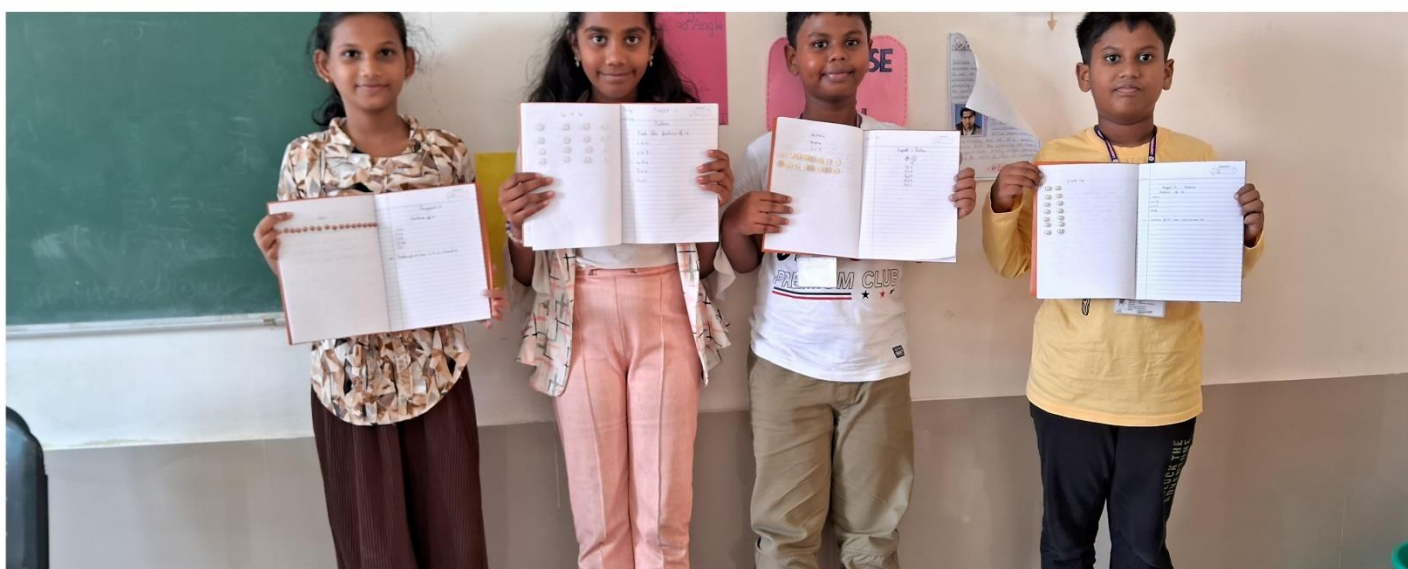
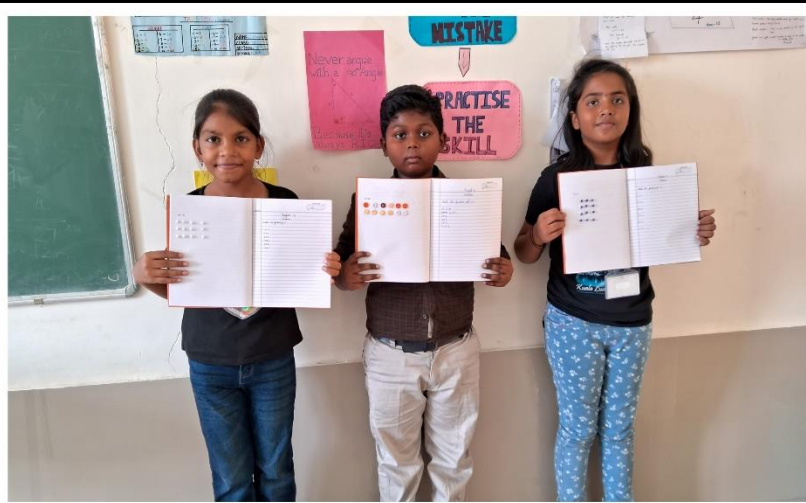
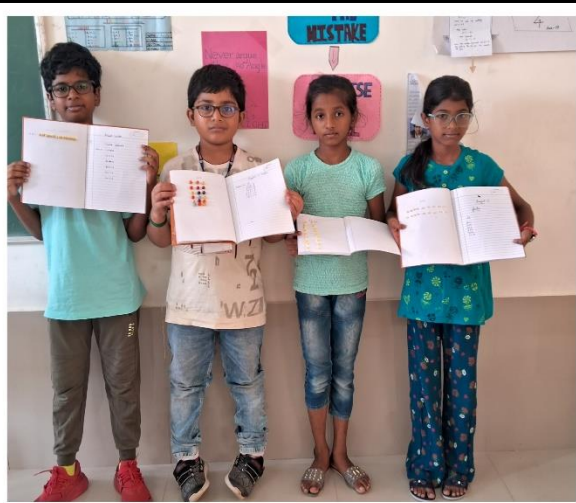
