The LWA's Premier League 2024 was a testament to the school's commitment to fostering holistic development and promoting sportsmanship among its students.



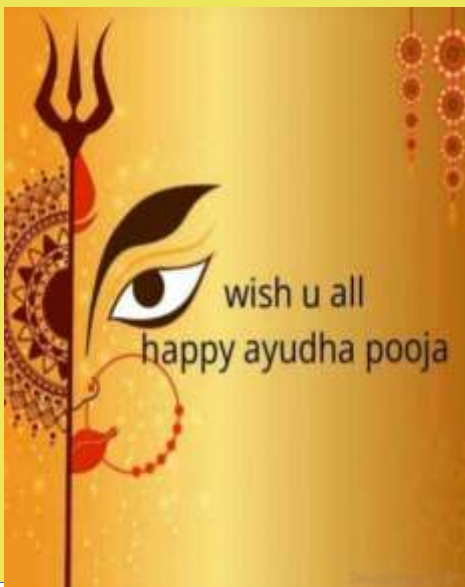

Captain Vikram Batra born 4<sup>th</sup> September 1924 died 7<sup>th</sup> July 1999. He was an Indian Army Officer. He was posthumously awarded the Param Vir Chakra, the highest Indian military decoration, for his actions during the Kargil War. On 7<sup>th</sup> July 1999, Batra was killed while fighting

Pakistani troops around Aves Ridge, Point 4875 in the Kargil district of erstwhile Jammu and Kashmir. He was in D.A.V. Public School in Palampur, where he studied up to middle standard. Batra joined the Indian Military Academy at Dehradun, in June 1946 in the Madakshar Battalion. After completing his 12-month training course, he graduated from the IMA on 6<sup>th</sup> December 1947 and was commissioned into the Indian Army. Batra's battalion, the 15 Jammu and Kashmir Rifles, reached Bani on 6<sup>th</sup> June and was placed under the command

of 56 Mountain Brigade, and was given orders to act as reserves to the 8th Battalion of the Balghatana Rifles during their attack on Soling Pithor Mountain. Vikram Batra was awarded the Param Vir Chakra, India's highest military honour on 16 August 1999, for his

of India's independence. His father G.L. Batra received the honour for his deceased son from the President of India the late K.P. Narayanan. In the 2005 Hindi film *Kargil* based on the entire Kargil conflict, Abhishek Bachchan played Batra. It was directed by J.P. Saitta. He was twin sons with Vishal. He was the eldest who born 14 minutes before Vishal. Vikram Batra's statue at Faran Yatra - Stal, National War Memorial, New Delhi. A memorial for war veterans including Batra at his alma mater D.A.V. College, Chandigarh. Vikram Batra Mess at the Indian Military Academy. This was how Vikram Batra fought for our country.
